We are unable to do any of this without the support of people like you who make the objective of traveling so far away during a pandemic possible.



## OUR GOALS FOR THIS JANUARY TRIP IS SIMPLE:

I want to encourage, motivate, and pray over the churches and their members.

My local team and I will be organizing leadership seminars for pastors and their staff.

We will be baptizing new believers in Dhanbesi and Rasuwa (small, rural towns).

We have plans to help complete the construction and furnishing of six churches.

School students and some of the poorest children will receive school scholarships through our Scholarship Program that ensures a good education (just \$25 per student). Our goal is to sponsor all 700 students in 2022, but we need your help in doing so.

Lastly and most urgently, we are hoping to purchase and distribute 2,000 Nepali Bibles (just \$3 per Bible). Our goal is to raise the \$6,000 in time for my travel to begin this month so that we can plan the purchasing and distribution sites accordingly.



I want to thank you from the bottom of my heart for your partnership and prayers! We depend on them more than you know, and God has been answering our requests thanks to the prayer warriors who are interceding on our behalf. You are such a force for change and greatly appreciated. Thousands will benefit from your generosity and know about a Savior who loves them, has died for their sins, and given them eternal life in Him.
